	<p>This is a screenshot of one of the 3 animations I made for the final sound rotation assignment. The first animation was based on a sound recording I took of people watching TV in the neighbouring room. I really liked how far away and muffled the recording sounds, it felt quite lonely. In order to capture that feeling I wanted to make sure that there is a contrast showing the distance between the sound and the room.</p> <p>The second animation was a reaction to a series of water sounds running from the pipes outside of my home. I thought the sounds were quite airy and it feels like it fills the space when you listen to it. To reflect that through imagery, I created something that resembles waves and the movement of water. I wanted the colours to fill up the whole page to capture the way the sounds fills up your ears.</p> <p>The last animation is imagery for a sound recording of me twisting plastic wrap. After multiple listens, I thought the sound reminded me of a very loud chewing sound. Which was why I created a repeated pattern of the same mouth animation. So that the volume of the imagery matches the loudness of the sound.</p>
